

2012 HARVEST BEND THE VILLAGE SWIMMING POOL RULES

1. Lifeguards must be obeyed at all times. They have the authority to remove persons endangering anyone or violating pool rules.
2. No talking with the guards while they are on the stand.
3. Only lifeguards are allowed in the pump room and the office.
4. There will be a 10-minute rest period for the guards every hour, at 10 minutes before the hour except for the last hour. Only Adults 18 years or older may swim at this time.
5. Head lifeguard on duty has full authority to limit the number of people in the main pool to the maximum ratio allowed for lifeguards on duty.
6. Swim suits only! NO SHORTS, CUT OFFS OR THONGS!
7. No running or excessive horseplay. (Excessive behavior will be determined by the guards)
8. No loud, abusive or vulgar language at any time.
9. No pets in the pool area.
10. No hard balls in the pool area. Large floats are discretionary.
11. No guns, knives or weapons of any kind in the pool area. Weapons will be determined by the guards on duty. If discovered, the lifeguard will call law enforcement immediately.
12. No electrical appliances. Audio equipment permitted with earphones.
13. No glass items in the pool, pool area, under pavilion, or in the park.
14. No food, beverages or gum in the immediate pool area (within three feet).
15. No alcoholic beverages allowed at any time.
16. No wheeled vehicles allowed (except wheelchairs and baby strollers).
17. No floating devices in the diving area.
18. No diving from the side of the pool in less than 10 feet of water.
19. Only one person on the diving board or stand at a time.
20. No loitering in the pool area — "pool area" includes under the pavilion and covered drive. Picnic tables are for the use of pool patrons. The lifeguard has the authority to ask anyone not swimming to leave.
21. Persons with an injury (such as open cuts or sores) are not allowed in the pool. Persons wearing bandages are not allowed in the pool.
22. Guardians of non-swimmers 12 years and under must be in the pool with non-swimmer at all times.
23. Children 12 years and under must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older).
24. Children must be 6 years or younger to use the baby pool and must be supervised by an adult. There must be at least one adult to every three children.
25. Only residents who have complied with the pool registration and their guests are allowed in the pool area.
26. An adult who is currently registered for the pool must accompany guests.
27. The number of guests is limited to a maximum of 4 per registered address.
28. Guests must leave the pool area at the same time that resident host leaves.
29. \$25.00 late registration fee, \$50.00 card replacement fee
30. Violation of any of these rules or any other rules adopted by the Board of Directors will result in revocation of your pool card.
